Dear Friends,

NOVEMBER is the MONTH of the HOLY SOULS: Holy Souls' envelopes (attached to last month's Newsletter) are still available at the back of Church, to be returned as soon as possible. Please enclose a single sheet of paper listing the names of your departed relatives and friends. A Mass Offering can also be enclosed for Requiem Masses to be offered during November, and throughout the coming year.

FUNERALS: During lock-down and after, most Funerals were restricted to the grave-side or the crematorium, without opportunity for a Requiem Mass. These are now too numerous to arrange individual Requiems, so we suggest that bereaved families select one of the November Requiem dates (on the Mass intentions list overleaf) to come on that day, with your family and friends, to offer the Holy Sacrifice for your departed loved one.

OUR CATHOLIC SHOP is open during Parish Office hours, 9am until 12 noon, for books, greeting cards, rosaries, statues, and other devotional articles. We still have 2021 Catholic diaries, and a good selection of distinctly Christian Christmas cards. Entirely new stock - with many items which we've never had before - is now on sale. Pop in on a weekday morning to get some inexpensive and interesting Christmas presents.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION PROGRAMMES resume this month to complete the courses for First Holy Communion, teenage Confirmation, and adult Converts on *Evangelium* RCIA, so that all these people can receive the Sacraments before Christmas. The new courses will then begin in the New Year. Watch this space.

JOIN US AT EVENING ORATORY via live-stream on weekdays for the 6pm *Angelus*, 20 minutes silent prayer with the Fathers and Brothers, concluding at 6.20pm with the Oratory Exercises in Latin or English.

HOPE FOR FOOD While the pandemic prohibits us from feeding our usual 100+ homeless rough-sleepers we've restarted collecting for Hope for Food's food bank to enable our partner charity to provide for the hungry. The green box beneath the table at the back of our Church is for your food donations.

PASTORAL VISITS: Please contact the Parish Office if you, or someone you know, is incapacitated or self-isolating, and would like to receive Holy Communion at home, or to have a visit from one of the Fathers, or from our SVP. "The Church comes to you, when you can't come to Church."

ORATORY LIVE-STREAMING: Br Francisco reports: "During October we had 11,755 viewers from 61 different countries logging on to the Church TV - all together almost 18,000 times, and the tally for the whole year thus far is quite impressive: 167,024 viewers have viewed us on the telly all together almost 300,000 times from 121 countries. Daily figures have been rising slightly again during the last fortnight of October." At the height of the lock-down we had 60,000 live-stream viewers per month (ie. 2,000 per day!).
