CONGRATULATIONS to Brother Antony who (on the Feast of the Conversion of S Paul, 25th January) was Clothed in the Habit of S Philip, and admitted to the Novitiate, as a Lay Brother of this Oratory-in-Formation.

RE-ENVISIONING OUR FUTURE: While life under lock-down has ground to a halt for many, the Oratory has taken the opportunity to embrace the inevitable changes which will follow the lifting of restrictions, and is imaginatively re-envisioning our future. This includes re-purposing Phase 2 of the Redevelopment (Halls etc) away from commercial use, to making provisions to work with partner charities for local people in need.

MANY ACHIEVEMENTS have been made in the past ten months, including successful grant applications for the security and care of our buildings. Guided by the Diocese (for whom the Oratory is their major project), we are applying for other grants for reopening, re-purposing, and for the major redevelopment. A Newsletter is in preparation to bring our Oratory Friends and Benefactors up to date with the Redevelopment, and to relaunch our ORATE fund raising appeal. We are immensely grateful to those who have continued giving towards the Redevelopment Project, and ask others to pray and think how they can do so during 2021 / 22.

WELCOME to Louise Farah, our newly-appointed Administrative Manager, whose expanded job description includes large-scale fund-raising, grant funding applications, and project management of Phase 2, for which planning permission is expected this month, with the aim for work to begin as soon as possible after lock-down.

VOLUNTEER for just 2 hours per week to work with our new Administrative Manager, as we revert to the Parish Office being staffed by volunteers for specific tasks. Please contact Louise to join our happy team.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION PROGRAMMES for children's First Communion, young Confirmation Candidates, and adults eager for Reception into the Catholic Church, have been thwarted by lock-downs each time that we've planned to re-start. We can brook no further delay to reception of the Sacraments by this Easter, and so all those who were on these preparation programmes before the first lock-down are being contacted to resume. Please 'phone the Parish Office for Zoom and other arrangements if you've not heard by mid-February.

JOIN US AT EVENING ORATORY via live-stream on weekdays for the 6pm *Angelus*, 20 minutes silent prayer with the Fathers and Brothers, concluding at 6.20pm with the Oratory Exercises in Latin or English, when we pray daily for those who send in prayer requests (via <Contact us> on our website) and for all in need. Our Evening Oratory happens to coincide with the daily 6pm Prayer for the Nation being promoted ecumenically.

IF YOU, OR SOMEONE YOU KNOW, ARE DYING OR SERIOUS ILL please contact the Fathers (via the Parish Office number below) who will bring the Sacraments, as usual, at any hour of the day or night.
