HAPPY NEW YEAR! With Christian hope we pray that 2021 will be better than 2020, and that the Tier 4 restrictions and other facilities, will keep us safer and healthy, as Places of Public Worship remain open (unlike the previous lock-down). All Masses are 'first come, first served' up to our increased capacity of 95.

THE CHRISTMAS CRIB remains in Catholic Churches and homes until the end of Christmastide on 2nd February - the Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, aka the Presentation of Christ in the Temple, commonly called Candlemass - when that day's procession of candles recalls Simeon welcoming Christ the Light of the World. Visit the Oratory Crib via our website. Click on live-stream, and then <Chapel>.

THE PARISH OFFICE and the ORATORY SHOP: You can use email, telephone or our website (see below) for Mass Intentions etc, and 'phone & fetch (cf. click & collect) during Office hours (now 9.30am - 12 noon).

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION PROGRAMMES for our children preparing for their First Holy Communion, young Confirmation Candidates, and our adult Converts seeking to be Received into the Catholic Church, are now planned to recommence as soon as possible in February, so that everyone can receive the Sacraments at Easter 2021. Please pray for those who are eagerly anticipating their new Sacramental life.

JOIN US AT EVENING ORATORY via live-stream on weekdays for the 6pm *Angelus*, 20 minutes silent prayer with the Fathers and Brothers, concluding at 6.20pm with the Oratory Exercises in Latin or English, when we pray daily for those who send in prayer requests (via <Contact us> on our website) and for all in need.

HOPE FOR FOOD While the pandemic prohibits us from feeding our usual 100+ homeless rough-sleepers we've restarted collecting for Hope for Food's food bank to enable our partner charity to provide for the hungry. The green box beneath the table at the back of our Church is for your food donations.

PASTORAL VISITS: Contact the Parish Office if you, or someone you know is seriously ill or dying and needs to receive the Sacraments at home. The Fathers will recommence ordinary pastoral visits after lock-down.

PARISH OFFICE FUTURE: Our Parish Office Administrator, Sharon Head (who has been very happy here for 8 years, and assumed this to be her 'all time' job) has been head-hunted by the Apostleship of the Sea and moves to a new role there at the end of this month. This has given opportunity to rethink things here as part of our on-going development, and recognising the way in which the Parish Office job has vastly expanded.

We are therefore looking towards a more managerial role - including project management of Phase 2 of the Redevelopment (ie. the Halls etc), of fund-raising and events, grant aid funding applications, management of Contractors, etc, etc, with continuing oversight of the Parish Office. The Office will revert to being staffed by parishioner volunteers (as before Fr Bruce). If you could offer part of a day, or a couple of hours, each week, please register your interest, and enquire for details. Meanwhile, very many thanks to Sharon for all that has been accomplished. Watch this space for details of a post lock-down celebratory 'thank you'.
