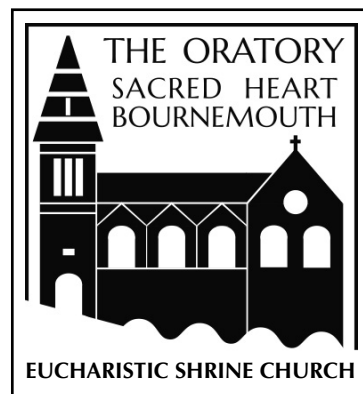

WE ARE to be a SHRINE of the MOST HOLY EUCHARIST. Bishop Philip has designated the Bournemouth Oratory as one of the 3 Shrine Churches in Portsmouth Diocese (with the Cathedral and Reading) for parishes, groups, and individuals to come on pilgrimage during the Diocesan Year of the Eucharist which begins on Thursday 3rd June, the Solemnity of Corpus Christi. We have an exciting and engaging programme planned, especially on Wednesdays and Saturdays which will be special Pilgrimage Days each week; an exhibition of world-wide Eucharistic Miracles; the 40 Hours Devotion; and Musical Oratories.

RESTORING THE SUNDAY MASS to its rightful centrality in our lives is what the Catholic Bishops' of England & Wales recent conference urges us to do "*encouraging each to take their place once again in the assembly of our brothers and sisters. We seek to nurture the sense of Sunday as "a weekly gift from God to His people"; something we cannot do without; to see Sunday as the soul of the week, giving light and meaning to all that we do each day; to see the Sunday Mass as food for the unique mission with which we have been endowed.* Our Bishop's Year of the Eucharist will strengthen this as we all play our part.
