Have your say by the 31st August public consultation on abortion centre 'safe zone'

Our local BCP Council has launched a public consultation into the possibility of imposing a Public Safety Protection Order (PSPO) around the BPAS abortion centre at Ophir Road, This would stop assistance and counselling being offered to mothers near the clinic and it would ban anyone from leafleting or praying in the vicinity. BCP options allow designated area(s) within the zone, but with so many restrictions as to make them virtually useless.

The buffer zone was petitioned to the Council by the 'Sister Supporters', who have accused pro-life members of harassing mothers, BPAS staff and local residents – this is far from the truth. People have been praying outside the centre and offering help for at least 40 years with no police charge or formal caution. Campaigns such as 40 Days for Life have done marvellous work through entirely peaceful means. This year the life of a baby was saved thanks to a simple conversation broached with the mother who, coming from another country, with no family or friends to help, felt she had no choice but to abort. She is still in touch with the woman who talked with her and gave her a leaflet.

A strong pro-life response is urgently needed to make clear that our religious freedoms, freedoms of expression and assembly are in grave threat, as are the lives of the unborn.
