

MORE ABOUT ORATORY PILGRIMAGES

Saint Philip Neri (1515-1595) Founder of the Oratory frequently took thousands of young people on Pilgrimage to the Seven Church of Rome. The Bournemouth Oratory follows in the footsteps of our Founder in these monthly and annual Pilgrimages to sacred sites and shrines.

We went on the UK Camino - 8 days walking through Kent to the Shrines of Our Lady of Mount Carmel & S Simon Stock at Aylesford, S John Fisher at Rochester, S Thomas Becket at Canterbury, and SAugustine at Ramsgate.

Most years we have a 3 day Pilgrimage to the 11th century National Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham in Norfolk.

The Oratory Day Pilgrimages are on the first Thursday of each month, annually from May to October inclusive.

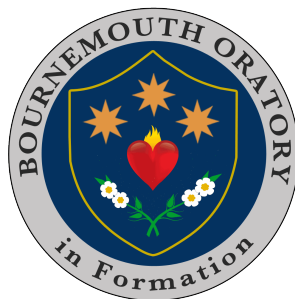
2023 Day Pilgrimages included:

(or earlier if places are filled by then).

Once your place has been confirmed
you will need to secure your booking
with a non-refundable 20% deposit.

The balance must be paid by **29th June 2024**
(Solemnity of Ss Peter & Paul - Day of Obligation)

There is an option to pay the balance
in monthly instalments, in each of
the six months, January - June 2024.

Cost includes

- Accommodation in rooms with private bathroom
- Breakfasts
- Daily luggage transfer
- Travel insurance
- Return flight
- Transfer to and from the airports (in the UK and in Spain)
- Lunches and dinners
- Daily Mass & devotions: Own Chaplain
- Guided tour of Santiago de Compostela and other *ad hoc* tours available from Santiago.

Alternative Six-day Camino

If you are limited by time, you can opt to return to the UK on Day 7 (Friday 4th) omitting the two days exploring Santiago.

The Cost reduces to
£1150 single room
£925 shared twin room
