Dear Friends

NOVEMBER is the MONTH of the HOLY SOULS: In addition to All Souls' day (2nd Nov) there are Requiem Masses throughout this month. See the Mass Intentions schedule on page 2 of this Newsletter.

UNDERCROFT DELAY announced by our Architect and Contractors a few days ago is extremely disappointing news! Constructing the new ramp to the main doors (replacing the perilous steps from Richmond Hill) has been delayed by the weather. For safety, liability, and insurance reasons we may not be allowed use of the Undercroft until there is more than one exit for emergencies. Arrival of the glass walls of the Shop and Office is also delayed.

The expected hand-over on 17th November has thus been pushed to January. A positive consequence is that we should be given Partial Possession of our new Café Neri (the former small hall) next week so that we can begin painting, sanding and sealing the floor, and other preparatory work. A second Partial Possession certificate for the main Undercroft hall and reconfigured toilets could be issued on 8th December to enable decoration of these areas.

Meanwhile the Shop continues in its old location. 15th December estimated completion of the new external ramp should enable access for Parish events.

IN FEBRUARY our self-help groups, Alcoholics Anonymous and Narcotics Anonymous, return to us (with thanks to Our Lady Immaculate, Westbourne for hosting them during our redevelopment period), and our S Vincent de Paul Society lunches. Café Neri also opens a little later in the New Year.

ORATORY PILGRIMAGES: Saint Philip Neri (1515-1595) Founder of the Oratory frequently took thousands of young people on Pilgrimage to the Seven Churches of Rome. The Bournemouth Oratory follows in the footsteps of our Founder in these monthly and annual Pilgrimages to sacred sites and shrines.

We went on the UK Camino - 8 days walking through Kent to the Shrines of Our Lady of Mount Carmel & S Simon Stock at Aylesford, S John Fisher at Rochester, S Thomas Becket at Canterbury, and S Augustine at Ramsgate.

The Oratory Day Pilgrimages are on the first Thursday of each month, annually from May to October inclusive. In 2023 these included: Winchester Cathedral; Dorset Shrine of the Chideock Martyrs; Isle of Wight Benedictine Monasteries of Quarr Abbey and S Cecilia's Convent; Arundel Cathedral and Castle.

2024 Pilgrimages include: Oxford in the steps of S John Henry Newman

- S Michael's Benedictine Abbey, Farnborough

- Thursday 20 June: Wintershall outdoor theatre production of the Life of Christ

AS WE APPROACH ADVENT let's not forget our Bishop's call for each of us to "change ourselves by deepening and renewing our faith so that Jesus Christ is truly the centre of our lives", calling us again to embrace the **SIX HOLY HABITS:**

- **to keep Sunday special, a family day, by attending Mass,**
- **to spend 5 minutes a day in prayer using the Scriptures,**
- **to do penance on Fridays (abstinence from meat) & serve the poor & needy.**
- **every fortnight to make a Holy Half Hour before the Blessed Sacrament,**
- **to go to Confession once a month, and**
- **to join a small group for formation, prayer, and fellowship.**



DIOCESAN YEAR OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

An Oratorian prayer for daily use:

Look kindly, Lord, we beseech Thee, upon our prayers and grant that the Holy Spirit may enkindle in us that same fire with which He miraculously pierced the heart of blessed Philip. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

STEWARDSHIP SUNDAY is the only day when our Parish Priest addresses us about money matters. We considered the Gospel for the 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time (Matthew 22:15-21) and Our Lord's admonition to *Give to Caesar what belongs to Caesar - and to God what belongs to God.*

Thanks to your generous support, and the very careful management of our Parish Finance & Fabric Committee, we have maintained stability in recent years, neither building cash reserves, nor running a deficit. But this is no longer possible on current giving. Even by further cutting back on expenses, tightening our belt and doing all else, the past year has a deficit of £15,000 - caused by (what we all suffer) increased energy costs and other inflationary pressures.

Our current regular Mass-goers (on Saturday evening and Sunday morning) give an average of only £7.30 each per week. While some give considerably more, some give much less, and some give nothing..! which (except in very rare cases) is unrealistic, and unfair to everyone else, and cheating God. Just to break even next year, everyone needs to give a minimum of **£10.90** per week. That's just 3 cups of coffee - and how many of those do you buy a week?!

It was proposed that there is one thing which we must all do:

Increase our Giving: Pray and reflect to give regularly, responsibly, and realistically. £10.90 per week = £47 per month, or £570 per year.

The three things which some of us could or should do:

- **Gift Aid:** If you are a tax-payer please sign a Gift Aid form. This diverts the tax which you have already paid (at no extra cost to you) from the Tax Man to the Catholic Church for the use of our Parish. During the past year we have been able to reclaim £12,000 in Gift Aid, but could claim much more if everyone signs a Gift Aid form.
- **Tithing** is Bible teaching, confirmed by Jesus in the Gospels, who teaches that we should give generously to God "*not neglecting the tithe*", ie. give to God more than the base-rate of the tithe (ie. one tenth, or 10%) from all that God has given to us.
- **Legacy:** During the past year we received £130,000 'out of the blue' from parishioners and others (some unknown to us) who had bequeathed a legacy in their Will. It is a Christian duty to make a Will. When doing so (or a periodic revision) please think about leaving a portion of your estate (or a specific sum) to our Parish.
