Dear Friends

ADVENT is normally four weeks, but this year only three weeks because the Fourth Sunday is followed immediately by Christmas Day. Both the Sunday and Christmas Day are, of course, Holy Days of Obligation...

Let's make the most of this year's very short Advent by recommitting ourselves to be faithful at Sunday Mass "whatever the cost" as our Bishop called us to do in his Advent Pastoral Letter, reminding us of the reasons for keeping Sunday holy, and the heroic witness of our ancestors in the Faith.

BROTHER FRANCISCO'S ORDINATION TO THE PRIESTHOOD (*Deo volente*) is on Wednesday 24th January, and his First Mass on Thursday 25th. Put the dates in your diary now. See the box display. We give thanks to Almighty God, to Bishop Philip, to the Seminary Staff, and to the Jesuit charity which has funded his formation at Allen Hall.

“YOU WILL BE MY WITNESSES” Portsmouth Diocesan Mission Plan includes amalgamation of local parishes across the entire diocese - some set to combine five, six or more former parishes into Pastoral Areas, each of which is destined to become a new Parish by 2026. The numerous parishes around Bournemouth are combining into three Pastoral Areas (ie. three new parishes), ours being the Sacred Heart, Central Bournemouth, and Our Lady Immaculate, Westbourne. We've already been working together over the past year, with joint liturgical and social events, and combining the Finance & Fabric Committees. The Diocesan given time-line is: September 2023 - November 2026 Develop; December 2026 - September 2029 Mature; October 2029 - July 2033 Grow.

The distinctive nature of the Oratory (as defined by our international Constitutions) doesn't allow for an Oratory to be part of a non-Oratorian parish, but accepts that an Oratory Parish may have 'daughter churches' attached to it, thus returning to the *status quo* when the Jesuits founded Westbourne from the Sacred Heart, as Deacon Roger reminded us at last year's initial joint meeting.

THE BISHOP'S ADVENT PASTORAL LETTER reflects that “it's easy to change the structures of the Diocese and its parishes - and structural change is part of the plan - but if we are to become a truly vibrant, welcoming Church that is collaborative and missionary, we must make the hardest change of all: changing ourselves. *You Will be My Witnesses* is about changing ourselves, opening our hearts, deepening faith and putting Christ at the centre of everything we do.” The Bishop's letter then explores the first of the Six Holy Habits: the vital necessity of being faithful at Mass every Sunday “whatever the cost”. Please read the letter (enclosed in this Newsletter) and respond prayerfully.

Here are a few of our Oratory activities (we have over 30 groups at the Oratory) relating to the last of the Six Holy Habit:

BROTHERS OF THE LITTLE ORATORY (a.k.a. The Secular Oratory) meet on 2nd and 4th Fridays, next on January 12th, then 9th & 23rd February.

WOMEN'S ORATORY: We aim to begin during Lent - once we have the Undercroft and Café Neri up and running. Like the Brothers, this is a way of making a commitment to the Family of Saint Philip here in Bournemouth, and receiving guidance and support on the path to holiness. There are few obligations, but it encourages members in prayer, frequenting the Sacraments, and in charitable service. It provides a space in which those devoted to S Philip can come together to support each other spiritually and practically.

CATH. SOC. - the Catholic Society of Bournemouth University and the Arts University (and all our students, and young people aged 18 - 35) meet on Sundays at the 10.30am Solemn Mass and for coffee afterwards, and for 6pm Benediction and Faith formation on 2nd and 4th Sunday evenings in term time.

DIOCESAN YEAR OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

An Oratorian prayer for daily use:

Look kindly, Lord, we beseech Thee, upon our prayers and grant that the Holy Spirit may enkindle in us that same fire with which He miraculously pierced the heart of blessed Philip. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

DURING ADVENT our Bishop's Pastoral Letter renews his call for each of us to "change ourselves by deepening and renewing our faith, so that Jesus Christ is truly the centre of our life", calling us again to embrace the **SIX HOLY HABITS**:

- to keep Sunday special, a family day, by attending Mass,
- to spend 5 minutes a day in prayer using the Scriptures,
- to do penance on Fridays (abstinence from meat) & serve the poor & needy.
- every fortnight to make a Holy Half Hour before the Blessed Sacrament,
- to go to Confession once a month, and
- to join a small group for formation, prayer, and fellowship.

THE ORATORY SHOP has copies of the new **one-year Sunday Missal** which begins this Advent (3rd December 2023) with all the Masses, Readings, etc for every Sunday and major feast days for the next 12 months. The Oratory Shop is open after the 10.30am Mass every Sunday and, from later this month, at its new location in the Oratory Undercroft and, from January, open all hours!

UNDERCROFT UP DATE: While we've had partial possession of the Café Neri space since 17th November (for Sunday coffee), we can't have possession of the large hall until 15th December, partly because of the delayed external ramp access.
