Since 1970 the GPMV Choir was primarily composed of serving and retired members of the regular police force and special constabulary from across Gloucestershire. Nowadays the majority are non-police members who just want to sing great songs, and have enjoyed entertaining people, while raising money for charity and good causes.

Over 44 years the GPMV Choir has helped to raise over £750,000 for numerous charities and good causes, including the Royal British Legion, Macmillan Cancer Support, the Ukraine Humanitarian Appeal, and now the Bournemouth Oratory Undercroft project.

Our Bishop's SIX HOLY HABITS continue from Lent into Eastertide:

- to keep Sunday special, a family day, by attending Mass
- to spend 5 minutes a day in prayer using the Scriptures
- to do penance on Fridays (abstinence from meat) & serve the poor & needy
- every fortnight to make a Holy Half Hour before the Blessed Sacrament
- to go to Confession once a month, and
- to join a small group for formation, prayer, and fellowship.

Refugees at Home - looking for hosts. The Refugees at Home network is in desperate need of new hosts in and around Bournemouth to join their short-term hosting scheme. People with a spare room are connected to refugees and asylum seekers in need of somewhere to stay. We recruit and support volunteer hosts who can offer a temporary home and a helping hand. Our role is to carefully match each guest and host, to assess and prepare them ready for hosting, to advise on hosting arrangements and accommodation, and to provide ongoing support to hosts throughout each stay. Each placement is different, and the length of hosting can vary from a few nights to several months and anything in between. Hosting is entirely altruistic, and we do not pay hosts for giving up their spare rooms.

Hosting enables our guests to travel to college, school, support groups or jobs, and retain their independence.
