

MORE ABOUT ORATORY PILGRIMAGES

Saint Philip Neri (1515-1595) Founder of the Oratory frequently took thousands of young people on Pilgrimage to the Seven Church of Rome. The Bournemouth Oratory follows in the footsteps of our Founder in these monthly and annual Pilgrimages to sacred sites and shrines.

In July 2023 we went on the UK Camino - 8 days walking through Kent to the Shrines of Our Lady of Mount Carmel & S Simon Stock at Aylesford, S John Fisher at Rochester, S Thomas Becket at Canterbury, and SAugustine at Ramsgate.

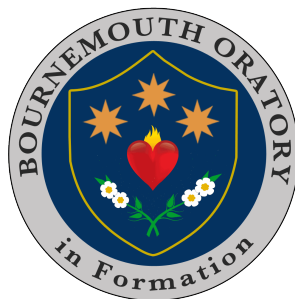
This year we have a 3 day Pilgrimage to the 11th century National Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham in Norfolk - Monday 23rd to Wednesday 25th September 2024.

The Oratory Day Pilgrimages are on the first Thursday of each month, annually from May to October inclusive.

- Oxford in the steps of S John Henry Newman
- the Benedictine Abbey of S Michael at Farnborough
- Wintershall outdoor theatre production of The Life of Christ, on the Catholic-owned Wintershall Estate, near Guildford (**20th June - 3rd Thursday**)
- Isle of Wight Benedictine Monasteries of Quarr Abbey and S Cecilia's Convent
- Shrine of the Dorset Martyrs at Chiddeock.
