THE NEW LECTIONARY

Everyone will need a copy of the New Sunday Missal by this autumn. See the box below for a special offer, exclusively from our Oratory Shop.

From October this year we will no longer need to print a 4 page Bulletin, and will revert to a double-sided sheet of A4, as everyone will have all the Scripture Readings and entire Mass text in their own personal Sunday Missal.

What is happening to the Lectionary and why?

The Lectionary - the book(s) that contain the Scripture readings for Mass and the Sacraments - is changing from the current Jerusalem Bible translation to the much improved English Standard Version (Catholic Edition), and the Abbey Psalter for the Psalms.

What effect will the changes have on the readings?

This long-awaited improvement makes the Biblical translations more faithful to the original languages, reflecting the best in biblical scholarship, and giving us a text which is both more proclaimable and more memorable.

When are the changes taking place?

The new Lectionary will become mandatory for use in all Catholic parishes and Mass centres in England and Wales, and in Scotland, from Advent 2024.

The Catholic Truth Society (CTS) was appointed by the national Bishops' Conferences to publish the official ritual editions of the Lectionary, which will be the only editions authorised for use in these territories. CTS is also publishing the ESV-CE (English Standard Version, Catholic Edition) Gospels, the Abbey Psalter Psalms & Canticles, and new musical settings of the responsorial psalms (composed by Fr Peter's former Organist, Dr Matthew Ward).

We are most grateful to a Parishioner for covering the cost of the new Lectionaries and related volumes, and for Gift Aiding the donation: £695 for the 4 volume Ambo edition, £395 for each of the Chapel editions (one for the Sacristy and private Masses, one for our House Chapel for visiting Priests on Retreat etc), £275 for the Book of the Gospels, and £250 for each of the Study editions (for the Fathers). Thank you!

The English Standard Version - Catholic Edition (ESV-CE) follows in the tradition of English versions (King James Authorized Version, Douay-Rheims translation of Bishop Richard Challoner, the Revised, Revised Standard Version, and New Revised Standard Version). Unlike the Jerusalem Bible, which was translated from the French, and only compared with the original languages, the ESV-CE is translated by the best scholars from the Hebrew (Old Testament) and Greek (New Testament), and S Jerome's translation in Latin (the Vulgate).

Bible Translation and the Making of the ESV Catholic Edition by Mark Giszczak (Augustine Institute) is an accessible comprehensive overview of how this excellent edition has come about. Obtainable from the Oratory Shop.
