Dear Friends,

Re-opening for Public Worship: We are delighted to announce that our churches are allowed to reopen for public Masses at the start of this month. The Bishops acknowledge that not every church will be able to observe all the legal regulations to open safely, or back to 'normal', and that this may take some time. We are advised to move gradually to ensure compliance with all the directives and guidelines.

Guidelines for coming to Mass & Confession: We ask you, please, to read the guidelines carefully on the back of the Bulletin and on our website and co-operate with our volunteer Stewards in church who are there to help keep you safe. Please note that our schedule for Mass and Confessions is not exactly as it was before the lock-down. This temporary schedule will be reviewed after a month, or when we are permitted to relax some of the safety precautions by the Government and the Bishop.

Parking Permits are available for the Braidley Road car park for Sundays 8am until 12.30pm. The 50 permits granted to us by the local Council are prioritised for our Musicians Bell-ringers, and Stewards, and those with special needs. - 1. Angels & Demons - Wednesday 8th.** What can we know about them? And does it matter?
- 2. Understanding the Catechism of the Catholic Church - Saturday 11th.** Understanding the Catechism's inner logic will help us to use this great gift of the Church, and develop our Faith.
- 3. Introduction to St Thomas Aquinas, Doctor of Doctors - Wednesday 15th.** In this Study Day, we learn about the Angelic Doctor's life and work, and how to begin reading his writings.
- 4. How Does Christ's Death on the Cross Save Us? Saturday 18th.** Are atonement, redemption, and salvation the same thing? Do Catholics and Non-Catholic Christians understand Christ's death on the Cross the same way? We study these and other questions about Christ's Crucifixion.
- 5. Heresies in the Early Church. Wed. 22nd** "There is no new heresy." Understanding those which the early Church combated will help us to recognise and counteract them in our own day.
- 6. The Unique Mediation of Christ. Sat. 25th.** "There is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus." (1 Tim 2:5) We consider why Jesus is the unique Mediator; why we pray to Mary and the Saints if Jesus is the only mediator; and the uniqueness of Christianity (compared with other world religions).
